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He is an author, co-author, editor, and co-editor of more than one hundred and forty research works in books, articles, and chapters. Chimakonam has delivered several invited lectures and keynote talks at universities around the world. He has been interviewed by many academic blogs and media outlets. His theories and concepts have been themes of international conferences and panels. His works have inspired several rejoinders, reviews, and theses.

His ideas are part of various universities' curricula and philosophy modules. He developed the theory of Ezumezu Logic and the method of Conversational Thinking, and he is a major proponent of Conversational Philosophy. Chimakonam has past and ongoing research collaborations with colleagues in other universities. He has received funding from national and international organisations such as the National Institute for the Humanities and Social Sciences, the National Research Foundation, the John Templeton Foundation, and many others. He is a logician, public intellectual, social thinker, and multiple award-winning philosopher.
