Structured Internship Scheme

RPNLU, Prayagraj has developed a well-structured and progressive internship scheme, aligning internship opportunities with the academic level and professional readiness of its students:

- **First Year:** Students are encouraged to intern with Think Tanks, Academicians, Tribunals, Commissions, Social Action Groups, and NGOs to build foundational understanding and research skills.
- **Second Year:** Internships focus on courtroom exposure through placements with Trial Court Advocates and Judicial Magistrates.
- **Third Year:** Students intern with Advocates practicing in High Courts and the Supreme Court, as well as Hon'ble Judges of Appellate Courts, thereby gaining insight into higher judiciary procedures and complex legal practices.
- **Fourth Year:** Internships expand into the corporate and specialized legal sectors, including Corporate Law Firms, Companies, and Specialized Law Practices.
- **Fifth Year:** Students are encouraged to intern in institutions or firms that align with their individual areas of specialization, preparing them for focused career paths.

This internship scheme reflects the University's commitment to nurturing competent, socially-aware legal professionals ready to contribute meaningfully to society. The University supports internships both within India and abroad, providing students with broad exposure and diverse learning environments.








Highlights of Winter Internships of First Semester students


