## **ABOUT RPNLUP**

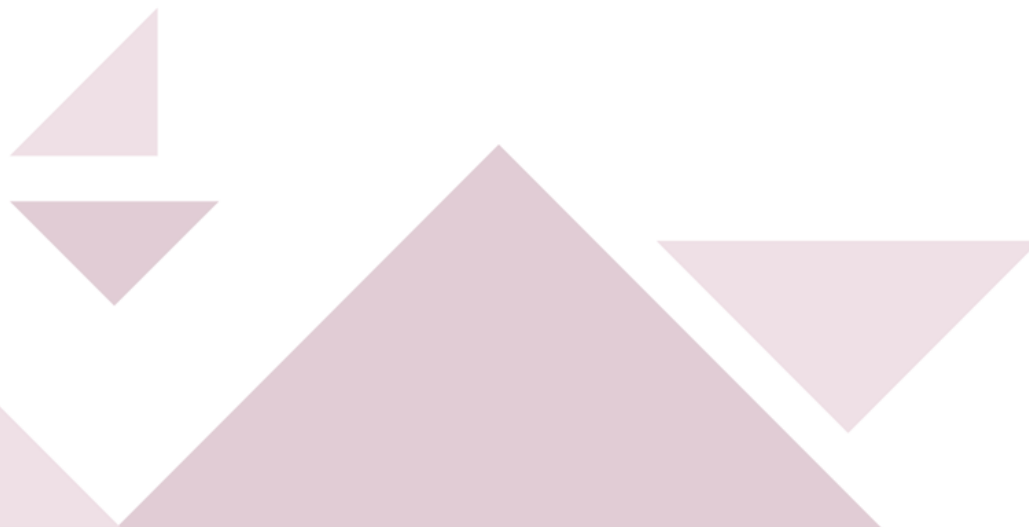

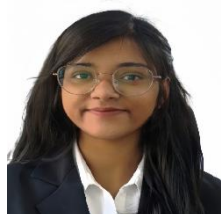

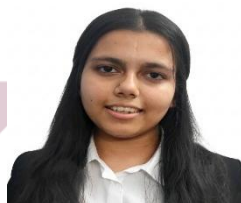

## **INSTITUTIONAL INTERNSHIP FRAMEWORK AND PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT MODEL**

Internships form a vital part of the academic and professional training of B.A. LL.B. (Hons.) students at Dr. Rajendra Prasad National Law University (RPNLU), Prayagraj. Emphasizing the practical application of classroom learning, the University actively promotes internship opportunities across a broad spectrum of sectors including law, governance, social justice, corporate affairs, and public policy. These internships are carefully designed to provide students with exposure to real-world work environments, helping them develop the necessary skills and insight required in their professional careers.

### **Structured Internship Scheme**

RPNLU, Prayagraj has developed a well-structured and progressive internship scheme, aligning internship opportunities with the academic level and professional readiness of its students:

- **First Year:** Students are encouraged to intern with Think Tanks, Academicians, Tribunals, Commissions, Social Action Groups, and NGOs to build foundational understanding and research skills.
- **Second Year:** Internships focus on courtroom exposure through placements with Trial Court Advocates and Judicial Magistrates.
- **Third Year:** Students intern with Advocates practicing in High Courts and the Supreme Court, as well as Hon'ble Judges of Appellate Courts, thereby gaining insight into higher judiciary procedures and complex legal practices.
- **Fourth Year:** Internships expand into the corporate and specialized legal sectors, including Corporate Law Firms, Companies, and Specialized Law Practices.
- **Fifth Year:** Students are encouraged to intern in institutions or firms that align with their individual areas of specialization, preparing them for focused career paths.

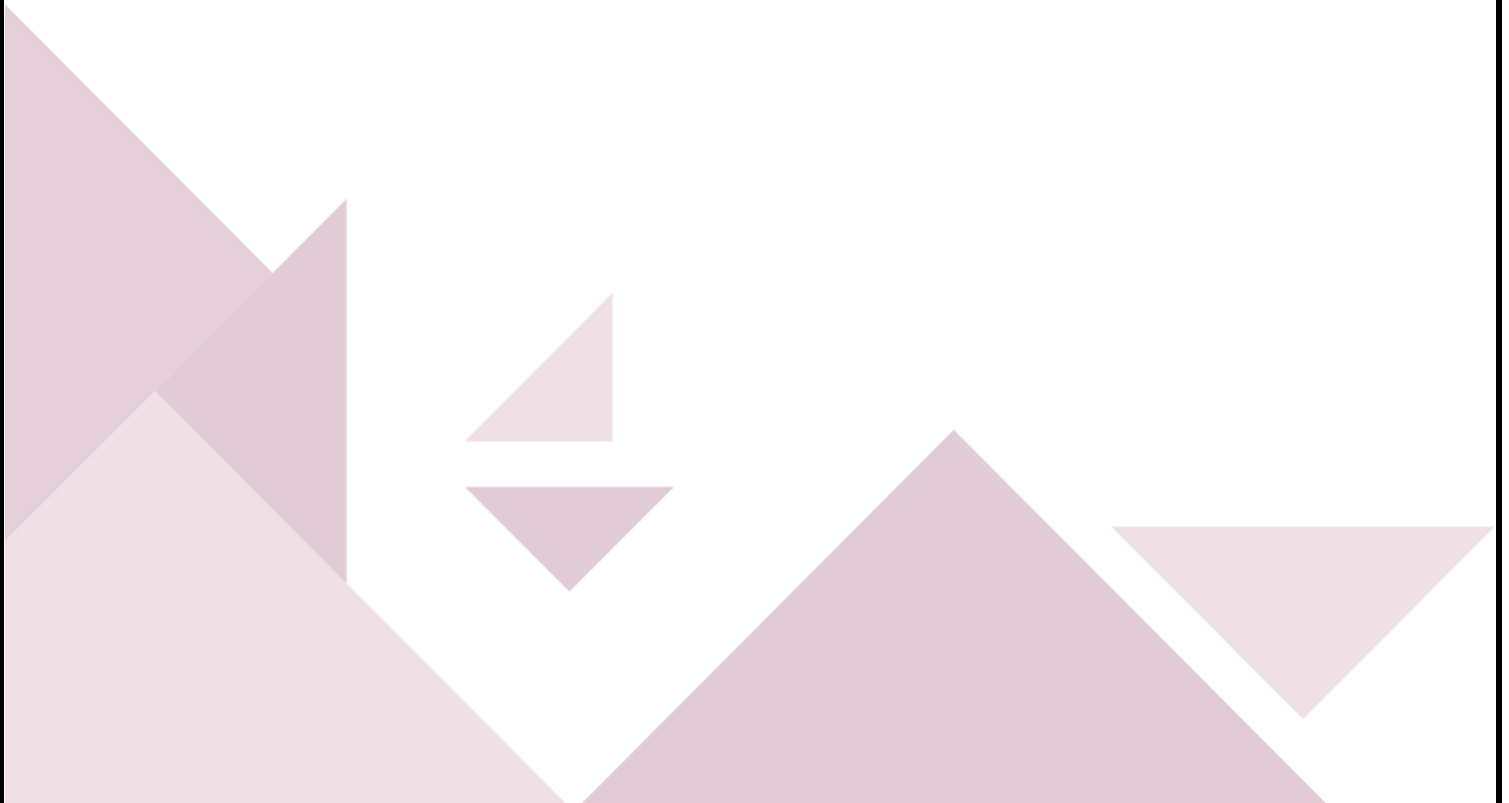

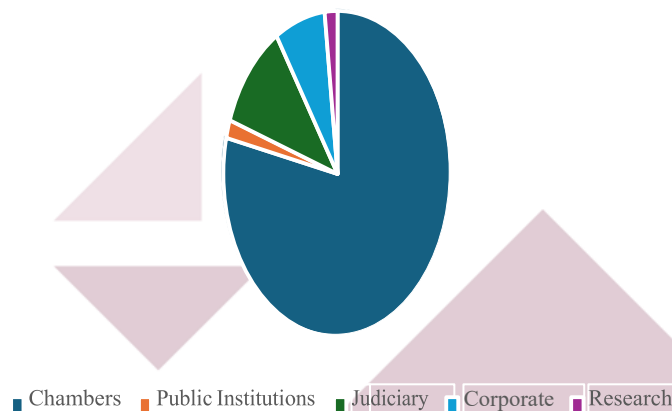
Thus, the preference for such internships reflects a deliberate academic strategy, to build foundational competence in the Second year before transitioning to practice-oriented roles in subsequent years.
